Family Day Care is a licensed service that is accredited under the National Quality Framework for education and care services.

Education and care is provided by qualified educators in their own home.

Experienced and registered educators provide education and care for small groups of children aged from birth to school age. The educational programs are guided by the national Early Years Learning Framework curriculum.

The Infants' Home Family Day Care Sydney Wide has three service hubs, offering education and care across multiple suburbs:

- Inner West Hub - Ashfield and surrounding suburbs
- Eastern Hub – Randwick, South Sydney, Sydney City and surrounding suburbs
- Northern Hub – Mosman, Northern Beaches and surrounding suburbs.



A home away from home

Family Day Care is just like home – your child will learn, develop and make friends in a safe and secure family home setting. Your child will participate in a range of planned activities such as story and music time, art and craft, dramatic play and active play.

Because of the small group sizes, your child will receive individualised care, and they will be supported to grow, learn and to experience a sense of belonging in the family day care setting.

Features of our family day care services include:

- Qualified and experienced educators
- Flexible care arrangements available – long and short day, full time and part time, before and after school care and weekend and overnight care
- Opportunities for siblings to be cared for together
- Affordable fees
- Services available in multiple locations
- Educators from a range of cultural backgrounds
- Quality, play-based educational programs that are planned and documented for each child to help them to learn and develop.

Coordination Units

Our Coordination Units are staffed by experienced and qualified early childhood professionals who work with educators to ensure the quality of the programs provided for children.

Coordination Unit staff will:

- Discuss your child's and family's needs with you and link you to a suitable educator
- Guide you through the enrolment process, including access to Child Care Benefit and Child Care Rebate to reduce fees
- Monitor your child's wellbeing, learning and development
- Provide training and support for your child's educator and monitor the service they are providing
- Ensure your Family Day Care service complies with National Quality Framework and regulatory requirements.

Costs

Fees are set by individual educators in accordance with Family Day Care Sydney Wide's fees and charges policy. Eligible families may receive Child Care Benefit or the Child Care Rebate to reduce fees.
