The Infants' Home Child and Family Services integrates early childhood education, early intervention and allied health services to create opportunities for young children and their families. We impact over 2500 children and families each year. One-third of our onsite services are directed to children with additional needs or living in vulnerable circumstances. Since 1874 we have protected children at risk and guided families to build their strength, skills and confidence to create a more positive future for themselves. As we look towards our 150th anniversary in 2024, now is the time to join the Board of this incredible, historic children's charitable organisation.

### About The Infants' Home Board and Committees

The Infants' Home Board meets 6-8 times a year (meetings 2-3 hours) at our premises in Ashfield and has an annual full-day strategy meeting. There are currently four Board committees (Audit and Risk; Capacity, Research and Reach; Fundraising; and, Property), and each Director is expected to serve on at least one or two committees. All committees meet quarterly, except Audit and Risk which meets 5-6 times a year. Committees often meet virtually for 60-90 minutes. The Infants' Home Board serves voluntarily.
